

Brief FUM 2021-4

The first council gathering for this semester was done over two evenings, and offered a few exiting moments. The first day started of with some technical difficulties. Then the council got reports from the elected representatives were they informed what they had done since the last meeting.

Afterwards it was straight on to discussing propositions and motions.

Propositions for the budget for UTN, along with the operational plan and budget for Techna during financial year of 21/22 was passed. These were passed without discussion, but that was soon to change. A motion was proposed to change the section the Master's Programme in Materials Science is supposed to belong to, from NVF to Q. The discussion continued for over 45 minutes where the opposing parties shared, among other things, excel-arcs with calculations (the one writing this didn't really manage to follow along) to support their arguments. After a vote it was decided to reject the motion, and therefore the programme will still belong to NVF.

The second day started of well, without technical difficulties. A motion was proposed from NVM that argued for UTN to have a position on the question about section rooms on Polacksbacken. This was also discussed at length. The Board argued for creating a working party that would work with this question. Which was passed.

Afterwards a few posts were to be filled. A few Student members of the board and Vice Secretary for FUM. Simon Andersson (F) was elected to Student Member for the rest of the financial year. Two people stood against each other to be elected for the second post as Student member. But before the election took place, Måns Bengtson, already member of the board, announced that, if both candidates was deemed fit for the position, he would resign at the end of the year, so that both candidates could be elected. The proposition to change the amount of posts was passed, and thereafter was Colin Daly (Q) and Caspar Norée Palm (F) chosen as new representatives for Spring 22.
